SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE:

S-L (1X-2X)

About 30 x 54 in. (32.5 x 60 in.) [76 x 137 cm (82.5 x 152.5 cm)]

Note Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jun 7, 2012)

FINISHING

Place marker 10 in. (25.5 cm) down cast off edge of Shawl. Sew cast on edge of Sleeve **to cast off edge of Shawl** between **beginning at** marker. Sew Sleeve seam. Weave in ends.

MATERIALS

- 470-143 Lion Brand LB 1878 Yarn: Claret
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Silver Reed LK-150 Knitting Machine

**LB 1878 (Article #470). 100% Wool; package size: 17.60oz/500.00 gr. (2045yds/1870m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

16 sts + 18 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

- 1) Wrap is knit with Stitch Dial at 9 throughout.
- 2) One cone of yarn is sufficient for several projects.
- 3) Refer to your knitting machine manual for instructions on how to cast on, cast off, work in Stockinette st, and decrease.

WRAP

Set counter to 000.

Cast on 120 (130) needles. K240 (270) rows. Cast off. Reset counter to 000.

SLEEVE (make 1)

Cast on 44 (54) needles.

Rows 1-7: Knit.

Row 8: Knit, dec 1 st each edge - 42 (52) sts.
Next Rows: Rep Rows 1-8, 7 times - 28 (38) sts.
Next Rows: K 3 rows.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Place marker 10 in. (25.5 cm) down cast off edge of Shawl. Sew cast on edge of Sleeve to cast off edge of Shawl beginning at marker. Sew Sleeve seam. Weave in ends.
