

Cast on Rag

30 needles each way, total of 60 needles (I made it 100 so I would not be too short)
Knit about 8 rows and
one row ravel cord.
Knit 15 rows
Hang hem from ravel cord. Last stitch will have 2 stitches.
Knit about 9 rows.

Cast off: transfer right stitch to left needle

Then wrap with a yarn-over (on stem of needle) and knit the stitch. (in latch part of the needle)

I preferred to **wrap it twice** first, **then knit the stitch**. This made a slightly bigger gap, which is easier to hang on needles when you use the rag.
