

DISH CLOTH

Row count 000 Mid gauge machine

E wrap 3 sts , knit 2 rows, pull out 1 sts on each side of your 3 sts, 5 sts total and knit 2 rows. Transfer center sts to next needle but leave empty needle in work position. Knit 2 rows, 7 sts.* Transfer the 2 end sts on each side over 1 sts but leave the empty needle in work position. Knit 2 rows * continue till you have 45 sts and are on row 44.

Transfer the 2 end sts, on both sides, in 1 sts. Transfer the now third sts from the outside in 1 sts on both sides leaving the empty needle in work.* Knit 2 rows and continue transferring till you have 5 sts left. * Transfer 1 sts on each side in one, 3 sts remain, transfer center sts 1 needle over, knit 2 rows, bind off.

SCRUBBY

Row count 000 Mid gauge machine

Keep in mind you need to gather the cast on and the sew off so that is why I used cotton yarn. Scrubby yarn will not always let you gather. I had you tie a knot in the cotton and scrubby yarn so as you don't pull the cotton yarn all the way out.

Don't put scrubby yarn in the tension dial. Just lay it over the top.

Pull all the way out, every other needle, starting with needle #22 right and needle # 21 left. Knit 1 row with cotton yarn. Hang cast on comb. Put all 44 needles in work. Cut cotton yarn and knit 22 rows with scrubby yarn, on 44 needles, pulling down on your cast on comb every few rows.

Tie a knot in the scrubby yarn and cotton yarn on the bottom left. Remove the cast on comb.

Thread a double eye needle with cotton yarn, enough to sew off your 44 sts and the side seam. Sew off the scrubby yarn then gather as tight as you can. Sew side seam. Then pull your cast on row as tight as possible. Knot off your cotton yarn and tuck inside of your scrubby.
