

Poncho with a Twist

Mid-gauge machine

I used Sensations Rainbow Boucle Self-Patterning. It's a medium #4 yarn.

I used T8.5 on the LK150 (I did not take a gauge. I just measured as I was going.)

Finished size of strip is 15-16" wide and 55-60" long.

E-wrap CO 60 stitches.

Knit even for approximately 15-16" and place marker. Continue to 55-60" or desired length. The longer you make it, the lower the drape in the front. I did approximately 280-285 rows.

Take off on waste yarn.

Re-hang with right side facing.

Holding strip out, take right hand corner and twist to the left. With the NEW right corner and starting on the right, hang side of strip between CO edge and marker onto needles. Make sure right sides are together. (This will form the back point, so think like a poncho. The end of strip is connected with the SIDE of the other end of the strip)

Knit one row at higher tension. Cast off. I used a loop to loop cast off. Weave in ends.

Lightly steam to relax the curl.
